Battle Buddy Application:

(NOT A SERVICE DOG APPLICATION)

Please read the following information before moving forward with the application.

- This application for a "Battle Buddy," not a service dog.
- Applicants must live in Florida and be honorably discharge veterans.
- Veterans cannot apply for a Battle Buddy and a service dog at the same time.
- Completing this application does not mean you will receive a Battle Buddy. It is the first in a series of steps. You might complete the entire process and be determined to be ineligible for a Battle Buddy. This decision is up to the Patriot Service Dogs team.
- You might be determined to be eligible for a Battle Buddy and put on a waiting list until a suitable Battle Buddy is available.
- The mission of Patriot Service Dogs is to train service dogs for veterans, not Battle Buddies. PSD does not specifically train dogs to become Battle Buddies—it is an alternate placement for dogs that do not meet requirements to become service dogs.
- Battle Buddies are companion dogs with no more legal rights than any other pet. If you receive a
 Battle Buddy from PSD, you will not receive a service dog vest.
- Battle Buddies are dogs that do not meet Patriot Service Dogs' standards for becoming a service dog. Reasons why a dog might be determined to be a Battle Buddy and not a service dog can include medical reasons, temperament, energy level, and more. The Patriot Service Dogs team determines when a dog will be eligible to become a Battle Buddy, not applicants.

Example reasons why applicants might be determined to be ineligible for a Battle Buddy (these are not the only reasons):

- Too many dogs in the home or unfriendly dogs in the home
- Not financially able to maintain the dog's care
- Applicant was disrespectful, rude, or aggressive to the PSD team
- Applicant needs a service dog

If applicants are matched with a PSD Battle Buddy:

- Applicants must give yearly updates on the dog and provide yearly proof of medical care.
- Applicants must be financially able to care for the dog (this includes quality food, vet bills, flea/heartworm medicine).
- Applicants must notify Patriot Service Dogs if they can no longer care for the dog for any reason.
- Applicants must never harm or use harsh corrections with the dog.
- The dog must remain a pet. It cannot be re-trained for another job (including home/personal guarding).
- The dog must live inside the home (not only at night and not in an outside kennel).
